SOLO SPOTLIGHT: As you can see from the above list of solos and duets, we have many students working on a high level of individual work. We require these students to achieve a 1st or 2nd overall or a National Title in order to be in one of our May shows. This means that for most of a day of dance competition the students must be 1st or 2nd of ALL the soloist/duets in either the 12 and under or 13 and older categories. DIFFICULT! Those above with an (*) have received the qualification and will be in our May show. We have wonderfully talented students and would like you to be a part of their achievements. While you are in your seats, awaiting our programs to start, we would like to have these students display their work without lengthening our shows. Therefore, about 15 minutes before show time we will present a few of these solo/duets before each show ...You will be amazed at the talent!! So enjoy!

CENTRE STARS Auditions: If a student is interested in joining or remaining on a Centre Stars tap or jazz team, we have a new procedure. The student must attend and pay for the summer classes with the existing team members for the 6 week summer session. During that time the students will be able to work on added skills needed by team members while discovering the level of the existing team. We suggest that a student be at least 6-7 years old and have the recommendation of their teacher to take the classes. After the team travels to Florida for the DMA Nationals, the team will be formed for 2002-2003. Taking the summer classes does not guarantee a position on the team, but does make all the students better prepared for fall class, whether team or regular class.

CLOGGING CAMP: The 2nd Annual Summer CoPA Clogging Camp will be held from 9AM to 4PM on June 24-28. Early drop off and late pick-up service will be provided. The camp is open to any clogger with at least 1 year of experience. Studio and special guest instructors from Tennessee and North Carolina will give students the opportunity to learn new clogging steps and routines, choreography, staging and costume design.
