Overview of Dress Rehearsals at Williams High School

- 1 Arrive before your stage rehearsal time in your costume and make-up. Remember to write names in shoes and costumes. Put your name, routine names and numbers on bags, costumes, etc.
- 2 Go into the auditorium if you do not have a costume change. Staff will come get groups to line up and bring them back into the auditorium when they have danced. If you have a costume change, put your costumes in one of the dressing rooms and go into the auditorium. We will not start a routine on stage, if a student is changing costumes ... we will wait.
- 3 You may take videos and pictures at rehearsals ... but not at programs as it is distracting to students and audience.
- 4 You may watch others perform or leave after your rehearsal is complete.
- 5 Pick up your proofs of individual pictures from Sheryl Harper in the auditorium.

Overview of Program at Williams High School

- 1 When arriving at Williams High, use the side steps to reach the backstage area to take students to their dressing rooms. Come dressed in costume and go to your dressing room. The Classroom dressing room will have assigned places to put class bags together. Students in other dressing rooms may bring things to play with between routines.
- 2 The side doors of the auditorium CANNOT be used during programs. When the doors open the light that comes into the dark auditorium distracts the dancers and makes the DVD light quality uneven.
- 3 Use the front auditorium doors for audience entrance. No one except staff and students in upstairs dressing rooms are allowed in the stage area. The stage wings cannot be used as an entrance to the audience.
- 4 Take your picture selection from your proofs to our studio gift table in auditorium lobby.
- 5 Please use time between routines to enter and exit the audience as a courtesy to students performing.
- 6 At the conclusion of the program, all students are in the finale and will come on stage for another bow. The staff will keep the young students at the front of the stage where you may pick them up. Again use the steps on the side of the school to get costumes and shoes from the back stage area.

The Program Order has only slight changes.

The routine numbers are different since groups and solos have been added.
If you would like to pick up a new program order, they are at the receptionist desk.
