Costumes The slip of paper with your name and list of classes also now lists the total cost of your costume. To figure the balance due, deduct the \$35 deposit from the total. (If the \$35 is in bold print, the costume total price hasn't been compiled as of yet.) The balance isn't due until March 28, but we wanted you aware of the balance so it is listed on your statement. The balance on your statement also gives you a chance to pay anytime between now and March 28. Costumes cannot be given to students unless the costume balance is paid and tuition and additional fees are up to date.

Statements We weren't able to print statements the month of January. Computer problems. This also meant that no payments could be credited to your accounts...so checks given in the last few weeks have not been posted. The February statement will have several items on it that are not due yet. The balances that are known for costumes are on the statement.
